International Wadokai Referee Certification



The GM in Luxembourg voted in 2015 for a proposal to implement an International Wadokai Referee Certification. The FWE Wadokai Referee Exam is voluntarily, and an additional offer to national referees. We have certifications for kata Judge A/B and for kumite Referee A/B.

Theoretical and Practical Examination:

The questions will be based on the WKF/EKF rules and questions, including the adaptations for the FWE. The questions will be in English and French.

The answer sheet will be multiple choice, allowing for fast control and results marking.

The written test is just after the referee meeting, on the Friday before the competition.

The practical test will be on the competition day, where the tatami managers will be asked on their opinion on the referees undergoing the examination.

Results:

Based on the theoretical exam, the input from the tatami managers and the opinion from the RC members, the referees undergoing the exam will get the results at the end of the competition, where the referees will receive their results, certificate and badge.

The dark blue outer circle represents the blue color from the European Union flag. The colors of the star segments are derived from the different national flags of the European Union member countries. The star is chosen based on the stars on the European flag, the 7 segments of the star represent the 7 distinctions of wadokai karate, differentiating wadokai from other karate styles.
